English Riding

Students are introduced to the basic balance seat necessary to excel in the English disciplines of Hunter/Jumper and Equitation. Advanced students may choose to focus exclusively on either discipline. Attention is given to the individual child's skill development, confidence, and performance.

Western Riding

Instruction is offered to students in a group format so they have the opportunity to learn from one another, as well as from the riding instructor. Concepts from all types of western riding, including rodeo, trail, horsemanship, reining and natural horsemanship will be introduced. Attention is given to the individual student's skill development, confidence and performance.
