



Christmas at Coteau
1st Annual Gumbo Cook-off
Saturday, December 8, 2018
11:00am – 3:00pm

Entry fees are due by Friday, November 23, 2018. For a list of all pricing, please refer to the Team Registration Form. Each team **must cook a minimum of 8 gallons of gumbo**. Monitors will inspect volume of cooking pots prior to cooking. All teams must cook their equal share in order to be judged as a participant in cook-off. Teams must provide all cooking ingredients and cooking materials. Rice may be purchase by contestants on site for \$10 per 120 servings.

- **Tent Placement:** All registered teams will receive their tent number and placement when they check in for set up.
- All teams **MUST** clean their own areas after the cook-off! Monitors will make inspections at the end of the event. Please bring containers for any leftover gumbo. Please **DO NOT** dump leftover gumbo in the grass or on the concrete.
- All contestants will have **hose water access**. There is no power accessibility for tents. Cook trailers are **not** permitted.
- **No vehicles** (strictly enforced) will be permitted within the designated cook-off area during the cook-off. Vehicle routes will be clearly marked for set up and take down.
- **2018 Event Details:**
 - Set-up time begins Friday, December 7 at 3:30 p.m.
 - Tear down time is Saturday, December 8 at 3:00 pm.
 - Serving TO THE PUBLIC will begin at 11:00am and last until 3:00pm or until the food is gone!
 - Christmas at Coteau will provide cups and spoons for attendees.
 - Prizes will be given for 1st Place, 2nd Place, and Fan Favorite
