We are resuming our Sacred Heart **group exchange** program in the spring of 2019 within the Sacred Heart network. This program, offered to grades 9-12, involves receiving a group of Sacred Heart students from a sister school, hosting a student, including them in our school life and community. Later Grand Coteau students visit them in their home country, get to experience their school / family life. As opposed to individual exchanges, our students take a trip overseas as a group that will be chaperoned by SSH Upper School faculty.

2019 Coteau-Perverie.

This is the Fifth edition of our program: Grand Coteau students, will exchange with the Sacred Heart school “La Perverie” in Nantes, France. Applicants will host French students at the dates of March 25th-April 2nd.



The SSH Grand Coteau group will visit their exchange students in France at the dates of April 17-30. The students will be spending an entire week with their host family, will go to school every morning as well as go on day trips in the surrounding areas. Sightseeing in Normandy (2 days), in Paris (4 days) and in Joigny Burgundy (1 day) are also included at the beginning and end of the trip. The price includes all costs: transportation, all meals, museums, activities, and accommodation in Normandie and in Paris.

- Duration: 2 weeks
- Cost: \$2800.00

SIZE CHART




Photo Guidelines
